make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is two unnamed streams #1 & #2 with stream #1 forming a reservoir, a tributary of Williamson River

2. The point of diversion is to be located #1 - 1020 ft N #2 - 450 ft W from the SE corner of SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 Sec 10 Tp. 34S R7E (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SE S.E. 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Sec. 10 Tp. 34S R. 7E, W.M., in the county of Klamath

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. 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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from unnamed stream number 2, with any deficiency from unnamed stream number 2 to be made up with an appropriation from unnamed stream number 1 and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-59552, Permit R-8200.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/40th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 10, 1979 for 1 c.f.s.; October 28, 1980 for 1 c.f.s.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 5, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
