do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Pine Creek, a tributary of the Walla Walla River

2. The point of diversion is to be located (1) 650 ft. South and ft. from the Southwest corner of NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Section 35, Township 6N, Range 34, EWM, an existing point of diversion for water right on Pine Creek on same property.

(2) Plus second point of diversion 200 ft. N and 400 Ft. E of SW Corner of NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, Section 26, Twp 6N, Range 34, EWM, also located on the West bank of Pine Creek being within the 1. SW 1/4 of the 1. NW 1/4 of 2. NE 2. SW

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.54 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Pine Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation (including winter irrigation)

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/60th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall not exceed 3 acre feet per acre irrigated during the irrigation season beginning April 1st and ending October 1st of each year; and not to exceed an additional 1 acre foot per acre irrigated outside of the aforesaid irrigation season

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is November 10, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 10, 1981 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
