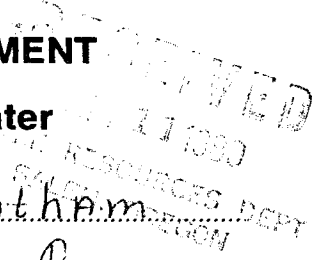

do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is ROW RIVER, a tributary of Willimette River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1100 ft S and 1370 ft E from the NW corner of Section 35, LAT 56 (Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 35, Tp. 20 S, R. 03 W., W. M., in the county of LANE

Remarks: When we first bought the first acre of land and house from George + Vivian Fraser we were under the impression, or assumed we had water rights from Row River. We have been irrigating from Row River for about 15 yrs. After talking with neighbors and friends we started investigating and found we didn't have water rights from Row River. In the meantime we purchased 2 more acres from Hoss and sold one acre to LaPorte. We now have 2 a. for which we want water rights.

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Row River

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 11, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 26, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
