6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Reservoirs have been in existence for some time, and storage was authorized by
Permits Numbered R-5298 and R-6416. It is intended that this application allow
the use of water from each Reservoir on lands for which a right exists for use
from the other reservoir, and to include new lands to be irrigated from either
or both Reservoirs. Diversion point #1 is set up for a 100 hp electrical centrifugal,
a 20 hp electrical centrifugal and a 5 hp electric centrifugal pump. Diversion
point #2 is set up for a 50 hp turbine electric; diversion point #3 is set up for
a 65 hp diesel centrifugal. This equipment will be shifted from one diversion point
to the other when the cropping pattern demands it, or the entire acreage may be
irrigated from one diversion point if the crop and equipment can be used that way...

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 250 acre feet of stored water only measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from existing Reservoir 1 and 2 constructed under Permits R-5298 and R-6416, being 98.0 acre feet from Reservoir 1 and 152.0 acre feet from Reservoir 2.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same lands and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 23, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 26, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
