make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Unnamed spring trib to unnamed draw
trib to Canyon Creek, a tributary of John Day River

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1310 ft. N (N. or S.) and 1480 ft. W (E. or W.)
from the SE corner of Section 28 (Public Land Survey Corner)

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Construction is spring box 6' x 3' x 3' located at spring mouth. Pipeline from spring box is 1 1/2' to valve, reduced 3/4" to house site. The length of pipe is 1300'. No pump or motor. Supply is gravity fed. Irrigation will be done by 3/4" garden hose.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed spring.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is October 6, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 26, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
