make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Woahink Lake

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1485.5 ft. North and 1452.6 ft. West from the East 1/4 corner of Section 14, Township 19 South, Range 12 West, W.M.

being within the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 14 Tp. 19S R. 12W, W. M., in the county of Lane

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Pump - 1 1/2 horse electric submergible.

Pipeline - 150 feet of 1 1/2" polypipe. 120 FT LIFT

7. Construction work will begin on or before July 1, 1980

8. Construction work will be completed on or before February 1, 1981

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before March 1, 1981

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Remarks: When we started this project of the construction of our home we endeavored to meet all the statutory requirements of the code. We were apprised of the necessity of "water rights" last week by the Veteran's Administration from whom we are receiving a loan.

The health department requires our septic field/to be 100 ft. from the lake. A well must also be 100 ft from the field, which in our case the water's edge.

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Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Woahink Lake.

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 12, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 26, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983.
