## To Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, E E Cotant

 State of Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the  
 following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to*

*one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

*The right to the use of water herein granted is limited to irrigation purposes,*

*and is also limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and*

*does not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by*

*others.*

*The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.08 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of*

*rotation. The priority date of this permit is March 16, 1920*

*Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1921 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1922*

*Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1923*
