DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM WILL CONSIST OF PLASTIC UNDER-GROUND MAINLINE (8" TAPERING TO 6") WITH 4" RISERS AT 40' INTERVALS TO SUPPLY IRRIGATION WATER TO 5 HEAD - 1/2" DIA. SPRINKLER LINES EACH HAVING 35 SPRINKLERS SPACING 6' X 6'. A COMBINATION OF ELECTRICAL CENTRIFUGAL PUMPS CAPABLE OF ~~100 GPM~~ DELIVERING 80HP WILL BE USED TO DRAW WATER FROM THE MARSH RIVER DIVERSION POINT & PUMP IT THROUGH THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM.



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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from .. Mary's.. River.....

The use to which this water is to be applied is..... irrigation.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated..... and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season..... of each year.....


