UNDER GROUND FROM HOUSE TO STORAGE TANK AT WELL

POD #2 - WOOD AND EARTH DAM 2' H X 5' WIDE - 175' OF 1" PLASTIC PIPE  
LAID ON GROUND FROM DAM TO 300 GALLON METAL STORAGE TANK -  
1" PLASTIC HOSE BURIED UNDER GROUND FROM STORAGE TANK TO  
HOUSE 100' FROM TANK

POD #3 - 1 HORSE POWER PUMP WITH 2" INLET AND 1/2" DISCHARGE  
AT CREEK WITH 1" PLASTIC PIPE LAID ON GROUND WITH  
STAND SPRINKLERS. DRAW WATER FROM CREEK WITH NO  
STORAGE TANK

### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed ..... 0.055 ..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from ..... three unnamed streams.....

The use to which this water is to be applied is ..... domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.005 cfs from from Stream 1 for domestic with any deficiency in the supply of water from Stream 1 to be made up by diversion from Stream 2, and 0.05 cfs from Stream 3 for irrigation.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... 1/80th ..... of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated ..... and shall be further limited to a diversion of not ..... to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,.....

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
