make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is A small, year round, GRAHAM'S  
Stream, a tributary of Scoggin's Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 420 ft. N and 385 ft. E  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)  
 from the SW corner of S31 Township 1 NORTH 4 AND 5 WEST  
(Public Land Survey Corner)  
Willamette Meridian, Washington County, Oregon  
(If there is more than one point of diversion each must be described)

being within the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of  
 Sec. 31 Tp. 1 N R. 4 W, W. M., in the county of WASHINGTON  
(N. or S.) (E. or W.)

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is Domestic, Irrigation, and  
Stock.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

A CISTERN IS TO BE BUILT 15 FEET DEEP OUT OF  
cement. THE HOLE AROUND THE CISTERN WILL BE FILLED  
with Sand AND DRAIN ROCK. PERFORATED DRAIN TILE  
will BE USED TO ALLOW SEEPAGE FROM STREAM TO BE  
FILTERED INTO CISTERN THROUGH ROCK AND SAND. WATER  
IS TO BE PUMPED WITH 1/2 HSP. DEEP WELL PUMP. WATER  
line TO HOUSE AND BARN IS TO BE PIPED 150 FT.  
Water outlets AT BARN AND HOUSE WILL ALLOW PORTABLE  
HOSING FOR GARDEN AND DOMESTIC USE. FITTINGS AT  
cistern WILL ALLOW PORTABLE IRRIGATION EQUIPMENT FOR  
USE ON UPHILL PORTION OF PROPERTY. PIPE IS TO BE  
1" AND 1 1/2" IN SIZE. 85 GALLON CAPTIVE AIR TANK WILL  
SUPPLY PRESSURE FOR HOUSE AND BARN WITH DIRECT  
manual controls AT PUMP FOR IRRIGATION. PASTURE AND  
GARDEN TO BE IRRIGATED WITH PORTABLE SPRINKLERS AND  
HOSING. CISTERN IS LOCATED 20 FT FROM STREAM.

7. Construction work will begin on or before Jan 1, 1981

8. Construction work will be completed on or before Jan 1, 1982

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before Jan 1, 1982

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Remarks: THE CISTERN AND complete WATER system will be professionally installed and the natural Beauty of the Stream preserved. THE STREAM ITSELF is not to BE Diverted in Any way from it's natural flow.

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### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from "Grahams Stream"

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family, stock and irrigation, being 0.005 cfs for domestic, 0.005 cfs for stock and 0.05 cfs for irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further water shall not be appropriated during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for human and livestock consumption,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is December 30, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 24, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1982

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1983
