from the S.W. corner of Section 31 T2S R4E W.M. (Public Land Survey Corner)

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

The system is in the design stage now. Most likely we will use a six inch pipe from the source to the ~~fields~~ booster pump. A 60 H.P. pump at the source and a smaller booster pump at the field. Pipe will be 1800' long <sup>to the booster</sup>. From the booster pump a 5" line will be used. A traveling big gun will apply the water and hand lines on the pastures. The main lines will all be underground.

7. Construction work will begin on or before Jan 1981

8. Construction work will be completed on or before Jan 1982

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before 1982

Remarks: The water is for growing crops on our dairy farm. We milk 130 cows and farm 161 acres on this place. Crops are alfalfa and field corn.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Eagle Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 21, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
