1. The source of the proposed appropriation is South Fork Alsea River  
a tributary of Alsea River

Legal Description:  
All of that portion of Tax Lot No. 300, Sec. 18, Township 14 South, Range 7 West, W.M., Benton County, Oregon lying to the West of Benton County Road No. 2; and lying to the east and north of an existing fence running along the east and north banks of the South Fork of the Alsea River; Excepting therefrom the most northerly 20 acres thereof.

4. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is 0.875  
cubic feet per second (i.e., 6.55 gallons per second).  
(If water is to be used from more than one source, give quantity from each)

5. The use to which the water is to be applied is irrigation of farm lands.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Existing works include the following:

The pump is a 3x4, 33 H.P. Berkeley diesel. Irrigation will be through movable 3 inch irrigation pipe with 50 sprinkler heads spaced 60 feet apart on the irrigation lines and 500 ft. of 4 inch main line.

In addition, at least 100 ft. of main line, 25 sprinkler heads, and additional irrigation pipe will be acquired.

7. Construction work will begin on or before April 1, 1981

8. Construction work will be completed on or before June 1, 1981

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before August 1, 1981

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Remarks: Please note that the attached USDA Soil Conservation Map shows a total of 90.2 acres in the Hennings field. This application is for those 70 acres which were not filed for under the July, 1980 application for permit No. 45176. This application is a re-application for water rights originally granted under Certificate of Water Right recorded at Page 20392, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates. That water right was subsequently cancelled through adversary proceedings.

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:*

*The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.875 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from South Fork Alsea River*

*The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.*

*If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,*


*and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

*The priority date of this permit is February 18, 1981*

*Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 15, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983*

*Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984*
