

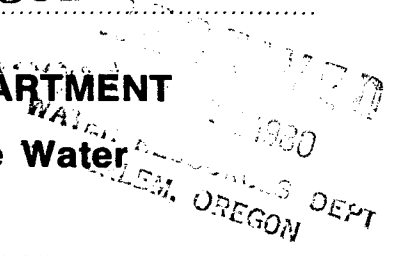

Application for Permit to Appropriate Surface Water

make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is storage from Phalarope Lake and Indian Ford Creek, a tributary of Squaw Creek

2. The point of diversion is to be located 1450 ft. S and 590 ft. E from the NW corner of Section 10 (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 10 Tp. 14 S R. 9 E, W. M., in the county of Deschutes

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

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### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Indian Ford Creek and Phalarope Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-60030, Permit R-8253.

The use to which this water is to be applied is recreation and fish habitat enhancement, being 0.025 cfs for each use,

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 14, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
