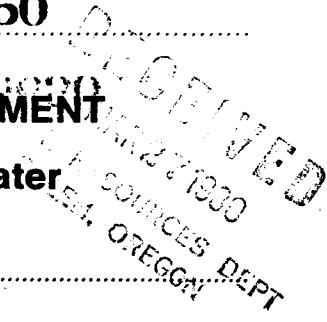

1" galv. pipe to tank with 10' fall

Spring #5 - S. 450' E. 800' from NW cor. Sec. 12 within NW 1/4 NW 1/4 sec. 12, T. 5N. R. 43 E.

1" galv. to tank with 4' fall

7. Construction work will begin on or before 1 May 1980

8. Construction work will be completed on or before 1 May 1982

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before 1 May 1983

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from five springs

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for two families and stock, being 0.01 cfs from Spring 1 for stock, 0.005 cfs from Spring 2 for domestic use for one family, 0.005 cfs from Spring 3 for domestic use for one family, 0.011 cfs from Spring 4 for stock, and 0.01 cfs from Spring 5 for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 27, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
