It's a very simple system  
a 2" pipe in the creek - gravity flow. <sup>Plastic</sup> Sometimes it is necessary to clean the intake valve and construct a simple dam from rocks in late summer to insure the pipe is covered.  
Length 6600 ft. of 2" plastic pipe (1 1/4 mile)  
We have the old Certificate of water right # 15375 which came from Rees in 1942.

(Chris Wheeler - state engineer)

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### Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed ..... 0.015 ..... cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from ..... Wonder Mountain Gulch .....

The use to which this water is to be applied is ..... domestic use for one family during the non-irrigation season and irrigation, being 0.005 cfs for domestic and 0.01 cfs for ..... irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ..... 1/80th ..... of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, .....


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is ..... April 25, 1980 for 0.005 cfs and ..... April 17, 1981 for 0.01 cfs .....

Actual construction work shall begin on or before ..... April 30, 1982 ..... and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19 83 .....

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19 84 .....
