Remarks: This is a reapplication for irrigation rights in our center field. Due to a number of circumstances we were not able to keep the rights current in that field. Now we have a new line buried in the field and would have had water applied last fall but then we had drouth conditions. We are now in a position to keep them current. No claim to use the waters as described by permits 36986, 36987, and 36988 will be made on the lands described by the application. We will be using the permits as we have the past several years, on the south side of fifteen-mile creek.

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

Permit to appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Fifteenmile Creek.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

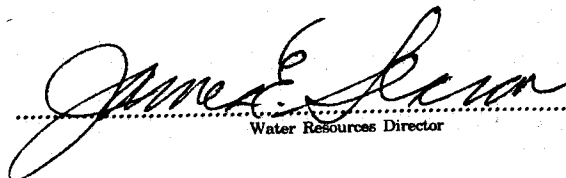
