make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is TYGER CREEK, a tributary of E. FORK ILLINOIS RIVER

2. The point of diversion is to be located 950 ft. S (N. or S.) and 2050 ft. W (E. or W.) from the NE corner of SECTION 19 (Public Land Survey Corner)

being within the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 19 Tp. 39 S (N. or S.) R. 7 W (E. or W.), W. M., in the county of JOSEPHINE

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.061 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Tycer Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-60667, Permit R-8267.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/50th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R- 8267.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is September 15, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 29, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
