DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

INSTALL TWO(2) CONCRETE COLLECTION TILES 3'x3' GROUTED TOGETHER WITH CONCRETE BOTTOM. COLLECTION PIPES (FRENCH DRAIN) WITH OVERFLOW PIPE. INSTALL CONCRETE COVER ON TILE WITH STAND PIPE IN COVER TO EXTEND TO GROUND LEVEL. CONCRETE SLAB TO BE POURED TO ACCOMMODATE A 1-HP FLINT WALLING (C-101) MOTOR & PUMP AND A 60 GAL. PRESSURE TANK (PP-108) USING APPROXIMATELY 1380 FT. OF 1 1/2" PLASTIC PIPE 200PSI BURIED IN A 24" TRENCH FROM SPRING TO HOUSE.

7. Construction work will begin on or before MAY 1, 1981

8. Construction work will be completed on or before SEPT. 1, 1981

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before SEPT 1, 1981

Remarks: WATER WAS TESTED 3/3/81 BY MEDFORD LAB
AND RESULTS OF TEST SHOWED THIS WATER TO BE SAFE
FOR DRINKING. THE WATER TABLE OF OUR EXISTING WELL
HAS DROPPED TO THE EXTENT THAT WE HAVE INSUFFICIENT
WATER FOR OUR DOMESTIC USE. WE THEREFORE CHOSE TO
DEVELOP THIS SPRING RATHER THAN DRILL A NEW WELL.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is April 6, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 29, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
