make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is UNNAMED STREAM

a tributary of FARMER CREEK - To NESTUCCA

2. The point of diversion is to be located 480' 5" (N. or S.) and 220' 1500' (E. or W.)

from the N.W. corner of SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec 1 T-4S-R-10-W (Public Land Survey Corner)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SE 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 1 Tp. 4-S R. 10-W, W.M., in the county of TILLAMOOK

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 23, 1980

Actual construction work shall begin on or before June 15, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
