DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

Well is in stream bed, consists of 2 sections of oval cement with covered top, is approximately 8' deep. Pump is Sears with $\frac{1}{4}$ HP Mtr, use 1" outlet plastic water pipe, use 2 oscillating sprinkler heads on a garden 50'x50', also use for small lawn & flowers. Water is stored year around, but only use for above for months of June thru Sept. Also water in this well is unfit for human consumption, due to several septic tanks to the north, had tests made but did not keep. We had to get City water (Coos Bay & N. Bend Wtr. Bnd - Coos Bay, Ore) for our use and also neighbors, so no one uses this stream for drinking water as far as we know. The amount we use for the above has never made any change in the flow of this stream. The well was put in before we came, we have lived here 9yrs, had to get City water in 1974

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from an unnamed stream

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year


and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 28, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 7, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
