Spring excavation will be approx. 20' long x 10' deep x 2' wide; with 3 perforated concrete pipes and gravel fill to collect spr. flow.

Pump is a 3/4 h.p. centrifugal. Pipe is 1" poly. Approx. 110' long to deliver to domestic storage site.

8. Construction work will be completed on or before Sept. 1, 1981





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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic for one family including irrigation

of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre lawn and non-commercial garden, and stock, being 0.005 cfs

for domestic and 0.005 cfs for stock.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second
or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is January 12, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 27, 1982 and shall
thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 19... 83

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 19... 84
