RESERVOIR constructed  
under permit R-7810, a tributary of Applegate River.

from the W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> corner of Section 28  
(Public Land Survey Corner)

7. Construction work will begin on or before ALREADY COMPLETED AND IN USE FOR THE 02 ACRE.

8. Construction work will be completed on or before MARCH 31<sup>st</sup> '82 FOR THE 1 ACRE (REMAINING)

9. The water will be completely applied to the proposed use on or before JUNE '82 FOR THE REMAINING 1 ACRE.

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Remarks: This storage water from the Applegate Dam will be used to supplementally irrigate lands covered under Permit No. 39572, Application No. 53331.

We have applied to the Water & Power Resources Service for two acre feet of stored water from the Applegate Dam, and they have answered that it will be a matter of <sup>a few</sup> ~~two to three~~ weeks before we will get a tentative contract.

This permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

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Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 2.0 acre-feet of / stored water only ~~2.0 acre-feet per second~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein; and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0301 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is May 29, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 20, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
