make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-7810, a tributary of Applegate River.

2. The point of diversion is to be located 425 ft. N and 525 ft. E from the SW corner of SEC. 8

(Public Land Survey Corner)

(Applegate Dam located in S 1/2 SE 1/4 section 25 T. 40 S. R. 4 W. W.M.)

(If there is more than one point of diversion, each must be described)

being within the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 8 Tp. 40 S R. 3 W, W. M., in the county of JACKSON

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

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**Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon**

*This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:*

*The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 6 acre-feet of stored water only ~~surface water~~ measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Applegate Lake Reservoir constructed under Permit R-7810*

*The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation*

*If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-WQ296 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director.*


*and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.*

*The priority date of this permit is July 15, 1981*

*Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 20, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983*

*Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984*
