1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Rogue River Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Permit R-8142, a tributary of Pacific Ocean

2. The point of diversion is to be located 165' ft. N and 900' ft. E from the NW 1/4 corner of SEC. 11 36S R3W (Public Land Survey Corner) (Lost Creek Reservoir located in SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and W 1/2 SW 1/4 section 26, T. 33 S. R. 1 E. W. M.)

being within the SW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 11 Tp. 36S R. 3W, W. M., in the county of JACKSON

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 16.5 acre-feet of stored water only measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Lost Creek Reservoir constructed under Permit R-8142

The use to which this water is to be applied is supplemental irrigation

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0305 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Director,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is July 15, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before August 20, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
