make application for a permit to appropriate the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is SPRING

, a tributary of East Beaver Cr.

2. The point of diversion is to be located 87.5 ft S (N. or S.) and 6.75 ft W (E. or W.)

from the SE corner of SEC 17, T35, R9W, W.M. (Public Land Survey Corner)

Sec. 20 Tp. 35 R. 9W, W.M., in the county of Tillamook

3. Location of area to be irrigated, or place of use if other than irrigation.

6. DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

Include dimensions and type of construction of diversion dam and headgate, length and dimensions of supply ditch or pipeline, size and type of pump and motor, type of irrigation system to adequately describe the proposed distribution system.

A RESERVOIR OF CONCRETE BLOCK SET ON A FOOTING 12' WIDE AND 6" DEEP MEASURING 6' WIDE BY 5' DEEP AND 24" HIGH INSET INTO THE SOIL AND COVERED. OUTLET WILL BE A 1" WATER LINE WITH 2" OR GREATER OVERFLOW INTO ORIGINAL PATH OF SPRING. WATER LINE WILL GRAVITY FLOW INTO A 1250 GAL TANK IF POSSIBLE. IF GRAVITY FLOW IS NOT POSSIBLE PUMP SUCTION WILL BE APPLIED ON TINED AND/OR FLOAT CONTROL TO MAINTAIN A MINIMUM OF 6" LEVEL IN THE RESERVOIR. INDIVIDUAL DOMESTIC PUMPS WILL BE SUPPLIED FROM THE 1250 GAL TANK. THE 1250 GAL TANK WILL HAVE A 1" OVERFLOW TO E. BEAVER CREEK. A 4" DRAIN IN BOTTOM OF RESERVOIR IS PROVIDED FOR CLEAN OUT.

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### Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from a spring

The use to which this water is to be applied is domestic for two families, including irrigation of not to exceed 1/2 acre lawn and non-commercial garden each

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 21, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 18, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984
