APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT

To appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

I, East Beaver Cheese Company of Hemlock, Oregon, do hereby make application for a permit to appropriate the following described public waters of the State of Oregon subject to existing rights:

If the applicant is a corporation, give date and place of incorporation Tillamook County, January 23rd, 1906

1. The source of the proposed appropriation is Woods Creek tributary of West Beaver Creek (Nestucca R)

2. The amount of water which the applicant intends to apply to beneficial use is one-fourth cubic feet per second.

3. The use to which the water is to be applied is Manufacturing and domestic purposes

4. The point of diversion is located in the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 18, Township 3 South, Range 9 West W.M.

being within the SE NW of Sec. 18, Tp. 3 S, R. 9 W, W. M., in the county of Tillamook, Oregon

5. The pipe line to be 12.83 chains in length, terminating in the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 18, Tp. 3 S, R. 9 West, W. M., the proposed location being shown throughout on the accompanying map.

6. The name of the ditch, canal or other works is East Beaver Cheese Company's Water Right

DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

DIVERSION WORKS—

7. (a) Height of dam 4 feet, length on top 15 feet, length at bottom 10 feet; material to be used and character of construction Timber and earth

(b) Description of headgate No headgate, only dam with wasteway 10 feet in width. Water will be run by flume 168 feet from dam into wooden tank, as shown on map, and taken from the tank through a 3-inch pipe.

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, subject to the following limitations and conditions: If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated, and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right herein granted is limited to the appropriation of water from Woods Creek for manufacturing and domestic purposes

The amount of water appropriated shall be limited to the amount which can be applied to beneficial use and not to exceed 0.25 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The priority date of this permit is May 22, 1920

Actual construction work shall begin on or before May 28, 1921 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before June 1, 1922

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before

October 1, 1923
