PROPOSED CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

PEARL BYRD,  
of P.O. BOX 1, DILLARD, OREGON 97432, has a right to the use of the  
waters of WILLIS CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the  
purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR TWO FAMILIES INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF  
LAWN AND NONCOMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46033. The date of priority  
is JUNE 15, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC  
FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the  
point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 41,  
SECTION 10, T 29 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 95 FEET SOUTH & 935 FEET WEST FROM NE  
CORNER DLC 41.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be  
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such  
right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 41  
SECTION 10  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted  
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right  
is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources  
Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
