Diversion Works - Height of dam 6 ft., length on top 80', at bottom 75 feet. Concrete - wasteway over dam. Gate valve 6". Length of pipe 3600 ft., size at intake 6", size at 3600 ft. from intake 6"; size at place of use 4" to 3/4"; difference in elevation between intake and place of use 270' max. Grade is not uniform.

Projection: 465 families and 8 commercial
If for domestic use state number of families to be supplied 365 residences & 6 commercial services at present. (what do you consider an average household number to be?)

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from ... Rock Creek

The use to which this water is to be applied is...Quasi-Municipal.....

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.....

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 3, 1980.....

Actual construction work shall begin on or before October 29, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.....


