## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 62151 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Janis M. Brabham of Route 1, Box 84, Gaston, Oregon 97119, Phone (office) 640-4275 or (home) 985-7925, for the use of the waters of Brabham Reservoir to be constructed under Application R-62150, Permit R-8312, for the purpose of irrigation and stock water, being 1.4 acre-feet for irrigation and 0.1 acre-feet for stock; that the priority of the right dates from August 7, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 1.5 acre-feet stored water only.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 1,509 feet south and 965 feet east from the northwest corner of NE 1/4 of Section 30, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 30, Township I South, Range 3 West, WM, in the county of Washington.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from reservoir to be constructed under Permit R-8312.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I South Range 3 West, WM Section 30 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 8.0 acres irrigation and stock

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
