PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 58865 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Charles D. Burrus of PO Box 306, Powers, Oregon 97466, Phone 439-4881, for the use of the waters of Woodward Creek, a tributary of South Fork Coquille River, for the purpose of irrigation and stock, being 0.15 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for stock; that the priority of the right dates from January 9, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.155 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: Diversion 1 - 2,130 feet north and 530 feet west from the southeast corner of NW 1/4 SE 1/4, being within the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4; Diversion 2 - 785 feet north and 670 feet west, being within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4; Diversion 3 - 215 feet north and 940 feet west, being within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 6, Township 31 South, Range 11 West, WM, in the county of Coos.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 31 South Range 11 West, WM Section 6 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 2 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Stock 7 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 3 acres

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
