PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 59914 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Ralph C. Rhodes, et ux of PO Box 33, Gales Creek, OR 97117, Phone 357-5169, for the use of the waters of Iller Creek, a tributary of Gales Creek, for the purpose of irrigation and homestead use being 0.004 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation and 0.004 cfs for homestead use; that the priority of the right dates from March 26, 1980 for 0.004 cfs and May 1, 1981 for 0.004 cfs and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.008 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 175 feet south and 990 feet east from the W 1/4 corner of Section 8, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, being within the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 8, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, WM, in the county of Washington.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further water shall not be appropriated from direct flow during the period from July 31 through September 15 of each year except for human consumption, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township I North Range 4 West, WM Section 8 NW I/4 SW I/4 Irrigation 0.49 acre and homestead use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
