PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 60632 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM PLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to City of Gladstone of 525 Portland Avenue, Gladstone, OR 97027, Phone 656-5223, for the use of the waters of Clackamas River, a tributary of Willamette River, for the purpose of municipal use; that the priority of the right dates from April 21, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 8.0 cubic feet per second of water measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 650 feet south and 200 feet west from the northeast corner of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, being within the NE I/4 NE I/4 of Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 2 East, WM, in the county of Clackamas.
