PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 61133 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Dennis and/or Shelley Bayne of Box 411, Glendale, Oregon 97442, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Cow Creek, for the purpose of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the priority of the right dates from January 9, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 500 feet south and 10 feet east from the quarter corner of Sections 31 and 32, being within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 32 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the county of Douglas.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South Range 6 West, WM Section 32 NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
