PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 61274 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Glen A. and Doloris M. Lloyd of PO Box 355, Taft, California 93268, Phone (805) 763-3800, for the use of the waters of O'Conner Creek, a tributary of Illinois River, for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the priority of the right dates from February 23, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: Diversion A - 375 feet south and 125 feet west from the northeast corner of NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4; and Diversion B - 50 feet south and 50 feet east from the northwest corner of the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4, being within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 8, Township 37 South, Range 9 West, WM, in the county of Josephine.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 37 South Range 9 West, WM Section 8 NW 1/4 SE 1/4
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
