PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 61564 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management of 3040 Biddle Road, Medford, Oregon 97501, Phone 776-4174, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Powell Creek, for the purpose of wildlife use; that the priority of the right dates from April 21, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 530 feet north and 440 feet west from the south quarter corner of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the county of Josephine.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows

Township 38 South Range 6 West, WM Section 23 SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Wildlife use

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1,
