PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 61691 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Earl Hvall of 1090 Dreamhill Drive, Williams, Oregon 97544, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of Powell Creek, for the purpose of domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial gardens; that the priority of the right dates from May 19, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 430 feet south and 320 feet east from the northwest corner of Section 15, being within the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 15, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the county of Josephine.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 5 West, WM Section 15 NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
