PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 61743 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Louis and Margaret Dalton of PO Box 406, Port Orford, Oregon 97465, Phone 332-1721, for the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Garrison Lake, for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the priority of the right dates from June 2, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 495 feet north and 1,245 feet east from the southwest quarter corner of Section 28, being within the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 28, Township 32 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the county of Curry.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 32 South Range 15 West, WM Section 28 SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
