## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 61835 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Buck N. Baker of 1884 Murphy Creek Road, Grants Pass, Oregon 97526, Phone 862-2409, for the use of the waters of Murphy Creek, a tributary of Applegate River, for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation, being 0.003 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.003 cfs for irrigation; that the priority of the right dates from June 24, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: Diversion 1 - 330 feet south and 490 feet west; Diversion 2 - 290 feet south and 450 feet west, both from the northeast corner of Section 2, Tax Lot 200, being within the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the county of Josephine.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed four and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 38 South Range 6 West, WM Section 2 NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic and irrigation of 0.5 acre

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
