PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 63046 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David D. Rood of Route 5, Box 858, Astoria, OR 97103, Phone 325-6439, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Walluski River, for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden; that the priority of the right dates from November 16, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 22 feet south and 450 feet east from the northeast corner of Taylor DLC 48, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 34, Township 8 North, Range 9 West, WM, in the county of Clatsop.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 8 North Range 9 West, WM Section 34 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden

Actual construction work shall begin on or before January 18, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
