PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 58413 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Delmer C. Robison of Route 1, Box 1530, Bandon, Oregon 97411, Phone 347-2757, for the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Davis Creek, for the purpose of irrigation and temperature control, being 0.075 cubic foot per second for irrigation and 0.86 cfs for temperature control; that the priority of the right dates from June 12, 1979 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.086 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 100 feet south and 835 feet west from the interior quarter corner of Section 13, being within the NE 1/4SW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 30 South, Range 15 West, WM, in the county of Coos.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second of its equivalent for each acre and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed three acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for caneberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 30 South Range 15 West, WM Section 13 NE 1/4SW 1/4 Temperature control of 6.92 acres and irrigation of 3 acres.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
