## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 58463 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Lela A. Bean of 41127 Highway 62, Prospect, Oregon 97536, Phone 560-3788, for the use of the waters of North Fork Rogue River, a tributary of Rogue River, for the purpose of domestic use for two families; that the priority of the right dates from March 29, 1979 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 590 feet south and 100 feet east from the west quarter corner of Section 29, being within the NW 1/4SW 1/4 of Section 29, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, WM, in the county of Jackson.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 33 South Range 2 East, WM Section 10 NE 1/4SW 1/4 Domestic use for two families

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
