PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 59501 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to George R. and Eva L. Murphy of 13253 Caves Highway, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, for the use of the waters of Sucker Creek, three unnamed streams, and a spring, tributaries of East Fork Illinois River, for the purpose of placer mining and domestic use for one family, being 8.0 cubic feet per second from Sucker Creek and 0.33 cfs from each of the three unnamed streams for placer mining, and 0.005 cfs from the spring for domestic use; that the priority of the right dates from November 13, 1979 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 9.005 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: Diversion 1 - 460 feet west and 1,100 feet north; Diversion 2 - 800 feet west and 830 feet north; Diversion 3 - 1,040 feet west and 632 feet north; Diversion 4 - 1,040 feet west and 203 feet north; and Diversion 5 - 1,040 feet west and 70 feet north; all being from the southeast corner of Section 12, being within the SE 1/4SE 1/4 of Section 12, Township 40 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the county of Josephine.

This permit is issued subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 40 South Range 7 West, WM Section 12 SE 1/4SE 1/4 Domestic use one family and placer mining

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
