PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 60705 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mert Loucks of PO Box 102, Cloverdale, Oregon 97112, Phone 392-3166, for the use of the waters of a spring area and reservoir to be constructed under Application R-60885, Permit R-8328, a tributary of Nestucca River, for the purpose of maintaining aquatic life; that the priority of the right dates from September 16, 1980 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 1,661.9 feet north and 594.5 feet east from the southwest corner of Section 23, being within the NW 1/45W 1/4 of Section 23, Township 4 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the county of Tillamook.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South Range 10 West, WM Section 23 NW 1/45W 1/4 Aquatic life

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
