PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 63031 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to David Wayne Birtch of PO Box 216, Dillard, Oregon 97432, Phone 679-4236, for the use of the waters of Willis Creek and three reservoirs to be constructed under Application R-61874, Permit R-8329, a tributary of South Umpqua River, for the purpose of maintenance of reservoirs for fire protection; that the priority of the right dates from November 9, 1981 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINTS OF DIVERSION are to be located: Reservoir 1 - 130 feet north and 90 feet east, Reservoir 2 - 330 feet north and 25 feet west, and Reservoir 3 - 1,000 feet north and 120 feet east, all from the southeast corner of Section 9; Reservoir 1 being within the SW 1/4SW 1/4 of Section 10, Reservoir 2 being within the SE 1/4SE 1/4 of Section 9, and Reservoir 3 being within the SW 1/4SW 1/4 of Section 10, all within Township 29 South, Range 6 West, WM, in the county of Douglas.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
