PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined Application 59782 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mr. Mert Loucks and Mr. Jack N. Colwell of PO Box 102, Cloverdale, Oregon 97112, Phone 392-3166, for the use of the waters of Roaring Creek, a tributary of Nestucca River, for the purpose of domestic use for two families and irrigation, being 0.01 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.1 cfs for irrigation; that the priority of the right dates from February 12, 1980 and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.11 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be located: 334 feet south and 2,185 feet east from the southwest corner of the NW 1/4SW 1/4 of Section 23, being within the SE 1/4SW 1/4 of Section 23, Township 4 South, Range 10 West, WM, in the county of Tillamook.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 4 South Range 10 West, WM Section 23 NW 1/4SW 1/4 Domestic use two families and 8.0 acres irrigation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
