PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60963 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Louis E. Heag of 8715 Wiley Post Avenue, Los Angeles, California 90045, phone (213) 641-5573, for the use of the waters of Grave Creek, a tributary of Rogue River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use and irrigation, being 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use and 0.044 cfs for irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 3, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.049 cfs measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,800 feet South and 1,320 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 9, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 9, Township 34 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Josephine.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 34 South Range 5 West, WM Section 9 W 1/2 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Domestic use for one family and 3.5 acres irrigation

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed four and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983. Extended to Oct. 1985

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984 Extended to Oct. 1985
