## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61029 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Robert G. Sicard and Sons of Route 1, Box 60, Boardman, Oregon 97818, phone 481-4071, for the use of waste water from West Extension Irrigation District, a tributary of Columbia River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation and supplemental irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from November 28, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 4.35 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 1,340 feet North and 2,150 feet East from the Center of Section 14, being within the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14, Township 4 North, Range 25 East, WM, in the County of Morrow.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenent, is as follows:

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed four and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 23, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
