## PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 60531 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Thomas E. and Doris C. Coultas of 300 Jordan Lane, Roseburg, Oregon 97470, phone 672-5470, for the use of the waters of Doerner Creek, a tributary of South Umpqua River, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of a lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from August 25, 1980, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 970 feet North and 30 feet East from the South Guarter Corner of Section 4, being within the SW 1/4 5E 1/4 of Section 4, Township 27 South, Range 7 West, WM, in the County of Douglas.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 27 South Range 7 West, WM Section 4 SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including one-helf acre lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
