PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61294 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Mark D. Hurst of Route 1, Box 64-A, Sheridan, Oregon 97378, phone 843-3185, for the use of the waters of South Yamhill River, for the PURPOSE of irrigation; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 2, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: North 60 degrees West 290 feet from the Southeast Corner of the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 31, being within the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 5 West, WM, in the County of Yamhill.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 5 South Range 5 West, WM Section 31 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 13.4 acres

The AMOUNT OF WATER used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed two and one-half acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983. Extended to Oct. 1, 1984

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984. Extended to Oct. 1985
