PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE THE PUBLIC WATERS

This is to certify that I have examined APPLICATION 61306 and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE APPROPRIATE MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

This permit is issued to Bryan and Wilma Craig of 537 Ridge Road, North Bend, Oregon 97459, phone 756-3772, for the use of the waters of a spring, a tributary of North Slough, for the PURPOSE of domestic use for one family including irrigation of lawn and noncommercial garden not exceeding one-half acre in area; that the PRIORITY OF THE RIGHT dates from March 4, 1981, and is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The POINT OF DIVERSION is to be LOCATED: 780 feet North and 760 feet East from the Interior Quarter Corner of Section 13, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 13 West, WM, in the County of Coos.

A description of the PLACE OF USE under the permit, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Township 24 South Range 13 West, WM Section 13 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Domestic use for one family including one-half acre lawn and noncommercial garden irrigation

Actual construction work shall begin on or before March 2, 1983 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983.

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984.
